KEY MESSAGES

The Central Eyre Iron Project Community Consultative Committee (CCC) has met and would like to provide the following information discussed at the meeting.

- The project is becoming more of a reality within the local communities and creating mixed views of the CEIP proposal
- The CCC had a presentation from the government regulator, prompting some thoughts:
 - This is an opportune time for influential community input during the development of the Mining Lease Proposal prior to it being presented to government
 - The community can influence the expected OUTCOMES and how they are described eg. IMPACT, RECEPTORS and SOURCE
 - The minimum time for statutory public circulation of a mining lease proposal document is 2 weeks however, if the mining lease proposal is a large and detailed document, or there is significant public interest, or for any other reasons, the regulator may decide to increase the length of the circulation time to any time period greater than 2weeks, which for example, could be 4 weeks, 6 weeks or 8 weeks.
 - The decision about the length of the statutory circulation period will be determined once the application is received and the formal assessment process begins.
- Warrambo Landowners are finding this time very difficult and struggle to see positives
- There was some confusion between an exploration PEPR and mining PEPR and their purposes

In summary, the regulator gave the CCC quite a bit to think about.
