Meeting Summary and KEY MESSAGES

The Central Eyre Iron Project Community Consultative Committee (CCC) has met and would like to provide the following summary of the meeting:

The welcome rain meant that farmer members of the CCC were busy with other things, so the membership was reduced.

The focus of the meeting was to finalise the work the members have been doing to identify what outcomes they would see for your community in the event the mine progresses. This is no easy task but we were able to finalise the list. This has now been made available to Iron Road for their consideration of how they might support these expected outcomes.

Examples of the types of outcomes members expect for your community include (just a snippet of the long list):

- community values that are maintained – a positive attitude, healthy community
- neighbouring farming systems and community not impacted by dust and vibrations
- district infrastructure upgraded and well maintained
- local business opportunities maximised
