## COMMITTEE MEETING

10 March 2015

### Meeting Summary and KEY MESSAGES

The Central Eyre Iron Project Community Consultative Committee (CCC) has met and would like to provide the following summary of the meeting:

Members had the opportunity to provide feedback and comment on the DRAFT Social Baseline and Social Impact Assessment that Iron Road has been preparing. Members used information already discussed on expected outcomes for the community to align with the information provided in the document. Iron Road will use the feedback provided by the CCC to revise the document in preparation for broader community consultation.

The CCC discussed the options for potentially utilising excess mine water for broader community supply. Peter Treloar outlined legislation currently being drafted, that if approved will allow third party access to supply water. Until there are any changes in the legislation it would not be possible for Iron Road to provide broader access. Peter will keep the CCC informed of any progress with the legislation.

The CCC encourage interested community members to attend Iron Road's "Talking Topics" sessions to gain an increased understanding of the technical aspects of the project.

#### Key Messages

- Discussed the Social Baseline and Social Impact Assessment and the proposed management measures and mitigation of potential community affects. There is further work to be done.
- Feedback from Wudinna Council indicates that the Kimba Road is to be kept in a safe and stable condition and that this will be reviewed annually.
- Feedback received by the CEIP CCC members from around the community, continues to question the future potential of the mine.
