1953

A reconnaissance aeromagnetic survey is carried out across a large portion of the Eyre Peninsula. Significant magnetic response is found in the Warrambo region.

1964

The SA Department of Mines and Energy undertake an appraisal of the viability of the low grade iron deposit at Warrambo and find it unviable in the current market.



1988 - 1995

Western Mining Corporation obtain the exploration licence and commence significant new work in search of Olympic Dam and Middleback Ranges style deposits and do not find what they were looking for.

1995

Adelaide Resources acquire the tenement. Their focus is the opportunity to demonstrate that an economic magnetite resource is viable and achievable through an iron concentrate.



2007

Andrew Stocks, Iron Road's Founder and Managing Director sees potential and the exploration licence is acquired from Adelaide Resources with ambitions to develop a world class magnetite Mineral Resource.
